#### **POLICY:**

- 1. In accordance with requirements of the Deficit Reduction Act (DRA) of 2005, all new and existing associates, agents and contractors, are provided with written information about:
  - a. The federal False Claims Act (31 U.S.C. Sections 3729-33);
  - b. Any state laws pertaining to civil or criminal penalties for false claims and statements;
  - c. Protections provided to individuals under such laws and the role of such laws in preventing and detecting fraud, waste and abuse in federal health care programs; and
  - d. The role of the Integrity and Compliance Program, the Standards of Conduct, and organizational policies and procedures for detecting and preventing fraud, waste and abuse in federal health care programs.
- 2. For purposes of this policy, agents and contractors shall include the following:
  - a. Independent medical staff
  - b. Volunteers
  - c. Students
  - d. Vendors
  - e. Contract workers
  - f. Board members.
